The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the previous were approved as presented on a motion by J. McLane, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried.

The liability forecast was suspended until the next meeting on a motion by T. Harmon, 2nd by J. McLane and carried.

Report From Standing Committees/The history committee met on 9/4/18 and decided on some potential changes in the landscaping for the Red House. We may purchase the shrubs and plant them ourselves if they will honor the warranty for one year. K. Childers will check with Wayne Bennett on when is the best time to plant and J. Tolley will check with Josh Raynes on the concrete. We also decided to work on a calendar for the town to sell for \$10.00 each. This will be put toward the landscaping project.

The health committee meeting is currently working on the fire works ordinance which will be presented to council once it is ready.

Sewer and Storm Water Board/ The Sept. meeting will be 9/13/18 at 7:00 PM. Currently working on the MS4 waiver. Sewer turned in 1,500 people when it should have been 200/250. This will be make a significant difference. Also the cameral run at the Ivywood sinkhole did not show any damage so the board will check and report.

Parks/The Sept. meeting will be 9/17/18 at 7:00 PM.

Streets/The Sept. meeting will be on 9/10/18 at 6:00 PM. The meeting with the railroad was successful and they were very helpful and will allow the Ash Street Crossing. We now have to meet with the Army/Navy and should proceed quickly with this project. Several ditches, Kings Tires etc were discussed to lay a 48" pipe and clean the ditch to help with the drainage
