The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the previous meeting was approved as presented on a motion by T. Harmon, 2nd by J. McLane and carried.

The liability forecast was approved for payment on a motion by J. Tolley, 2nd by R. Hull & carried.

The purchase request form was approved for up to \$100.00 on a upon a motion by K.Childers, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried.

Park Board will have the pool employees orientation on May 6, at 6:00 PM and then proceed with the regular park board meeting. Board hired 14 lifeguards & 6 cashiers. CPO classes for town employees was approved. Board also agreed on a motion by K. Childers to send Carl & John to get their certification for the pool at \$590.00 2nd by T. Harmon & carried. Ron McDade also has his pool certification for the pool.

History committee meeting agreed to proceed with getting bids on the landscaping out on back lawn. Valley \$7,350.00 Hillcrest \$10,730.00 for pergola only. K. Childers made the motion to proceed with Parsons contracting who was the low bid of \$18,000 for all work & a motion by K. Childers was made to proceed, 2nd by J. McLane & carried. Will proceed immediately to meet the June 30th deadline. Event committee is planning the Memorial Day Service on May 25th at 6:30 refreshments and service beginning 7:30 PM. Also began planning the town picnic in October.

The street committee took bids for the work needed in Cedar Hills and went with Casto Concrete at \$11.00 per sq. ft. for the needed repairs on a motion by J. Tolley, 2nd y T. Harmon & carried. This will include the needed curb work that was poorly done and the bad place in front of Evan Bias' house. Next meeting will be May 9th at 6:00 PM.

Sewer board will meet next time on May 9th at 7:00 PM.

Storm Water Board will have their next meeting on May 9th at 7:30 PM.

Health Committee reported on clean up day. Four dumpsters were filled T. Harmon obtained a \$500.00 grant from Solid Waste to help with this event. We can no longer burn brush in the park and this will cause some problems for getting rid of all the brush all over town. We will look in to other options for next meeting. Cindy Farley of the Putnam County Rotary Club is planning a comfort station (self contained) for down in the park.

Police Committee/ Chief Wingo reported that the car show at the PCTC was a huge success with over 90 Cars registering. Great weather and the EVFD had success with their concessions. Will try to make this an annual event.

Chief Wingo also presented an application from Steve Jones, an X State Trooper to fill the park time job needed for the town. J. Tolley made the motion to hire him at \$15.00 per hour, 2nd by K. Childers & carried.

Report from Officers of the Town/J. Tolley would like to proceed with getting information on selling the property adjacent to the Police Department and ear marking the money to the Red House. Will check into this and advise next meeting. This was decided on a motion by J. Tolley, 2nd by R. Hull & carried.

John Demules has agreed to redo the signs for the town at \$350.00 per sign. A motion by J. Tolley to begin with the police, library and front signs, 2nd by J. McLane & carried.

Council discussed giving the EVFD a donation with the \$10,000 paid by Fire Service Board and agreed to talk with Dave Turley about their future projects before deciding on an amount.

Council also discussed checking further into the tax collection service for next meeting.
