Report From Standing Committees/ -0-

Report From Officers of the Town/

A special meeting was held with our town attorney, Tim LaFon, going over the drug program that the town now has. Mr. LaFon presented copies of a program that he feels is best for the town and a motion to go with it was made by J. Tolley, 2<sup>nd</sup> by K. Childers and carried. Lynda will call Mr. LaFon to have the

proposal corrected to the Town of Eleanor and a sign off sheet from the employees added to the back for their personnel file. Once the employees have been informed of the program amended we will begin random drug testing for any employee using equipment, cars, etc for the Town of Eleanor. Also will introduce drug testing prior to hiring employees.

J.. Tolley informed council that he has a meeting with an architect to look at the house at 917 Roosevelt Blvd. to see what we need to do to begin getting grants for this project.
