The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the previous meeting was approved as presented on a motion by T. Harmon, 2nd by J. McLane and carried.

The liability forecast was approved for payment on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by J. Tolley & carried.

The purchase request form for office supplies was approved on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried.

Under parks the town has been working on the pool to get ready for the upcoming Memorial Day Weekend. The 4-H has worked in the park, painting the fence and cleaning up. The orientation for the pool employees went well and they have been working on cleaning up the pool and pool area. We now have three people who are certified to run the pool, Carl Neal, John Watson & Ron McDade. We have hired Henry Patton to weed eat for the town beginning next week. This will help and he can begin working after school at this time. Gary Jividen has been appointed the resident Park Board member and the board is happy to have him. Next meeting will be June 3rd at 6:00 PM.

The event planning committee is currently planning the fall picnic and have tentatively set the date for October 12th. It will be like the events from the last year. Next meeting is June 4th, at 5:30 PM.

Next meeting for the history committee will be June 4th at 6:30 PM.

Street committee will be working on the streets in Cedar Hills. Would like to start in June. Redo the berm work that was previously done and repair work in front of Evan Bias home. Next meeting is June 13th at 6:00 PM.

Storm Water board is looking at a recurring sinkhole on Ivywood Street. The new generator is in and will be installing the next couple of weeks. Marisa Grace with Steptoe & Johnson is working on the MS4 waiver at this time. Next meeting Les Adkins is bringing a proposal for smoke testing. Next meeting is June 13th at 7:30 PM.

Police Committee-Larry Wingo brought Steve Jones of the PCTC who is going to work part time to meet the Mayor, Recorder & council. Larry feels Steve will be a great fit for the town. Next meeting will be June 24th at 6:00 PM.

Report From Officers of the Town/Once again the council discussed selling the property adjacent to the police department and will obtain information further for future meetings. The council discussed further landscaping at the Town Hall and will do whatever we need to submit our bill to the county by June 30th to get our grant money. We would like to check on white tents and white plastic chairs that could be rented from the town for weddings or parties. We also need to discuss new rental forms. Council, after talking with EVFD has agreed to donate back \$2500.00 on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by J. Tolley and carried.

The town once again discussed the removal of brush, etc for town residents but have not come up with a solution yet since it CANNOT be burned any longer. We will continue to work on this. The grant from the county for projects is due July 31st and council will decide what to submit. The town is still working on the meters in the park and will have ready for the fair in July.
