## **Town Business Licenses**

Any person or entity who conducts business in, or whose business is based in Eleanor must obtain a business license from the town hall.

Business license taxes are based on the tax rate associated with your assigned business classification. The full tax rate sheet can be viewed online by visiting the ordinance link or in person at the town hall.

The fees and taxes pertaining to business licenses have been in place for many years. This program is essential to the overall well-being of our community since it provides a funding source for our streets, parks, police department and other essential services.

## Golf Carts & ATV's

The town received a great response to last month's information regarding golf cart and ATV permits. Thank you to those who visited the town hall and met with Chief Wingo to update or fill out your registration paperwork.

## **Lost Bicycle?**

The town has recovered many bicycles over the last 5+ years. Please call or visit the town hall to inquire about a lost bike. You will need to leave your name, number, date the bicycle went missing and a detailed description of the bicycle.

Chief Wingo will verify and return the bike to you if your information matches any of the unclaimed bikes.

All bicycles unclaimed after September will be donated to a local charity organization.

# **Town Building Permits**

Any person or business undertaking any construction, reconstruction, enlargement, alteration, relocation or demolition for any type of structure in town limits will need to first obtain a town building permit. The permit will allow you and/or your contractor to proceed with the project safely and in compliance with the town ordinances.

Building permits are also required for the installation of tile, drain pipe or culvert in a ditch line for any purpose which may effect the flow of water.

Applications for such building permits shall be made, in writing, to the Town of Eleanor on an application supplied by the Town. Fees associated with building permits are directly related to the cost of the project.

For residential, any project estimated to cost between \$0.00 and \$1,000 the permit will be \$1.00. For each additional \$1,000 or part thereof beyond the initial \$1,000 will be an additional \$2.00.

For commercial, any project estimated to cost between \$0.00 and \$1,000 the permit will be \$2.00. Each additional \$1,000 or part thereof beyond the initial \$1,000 will be an additional \$3.00.

The town Building Inspector will visit the site of the project to answer any questions and to approve of the work. The Mayor will also sign the permit prior to the start of the project.

Please visit the town hall to obtain a permit application or to ask questions related to an upcoming project.
