A regular meeting of the town council of the Town of Eleanor was held at 7:30 PM.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as presented on a motion by T. Harmon, 2nd by J. McLane & carried.

The liability forecast was approved for payment on a motion by J. Tolley, 2nd by K. Childers & carried.

Purchase Request Form -0-

Report from Officers of the Town/ Mayor Clendenin reported on his meeting with the County Commission awarding the Town of Eleanor, \$23,482.00 to be spent on the new gazebo at the town park. Our percentage to be matched is 20% totaling \$4,696.40. We will start on this project soon. Reminder to everyone, there will be a meeting on Sept. 19th to discuss options for the town election.

Standing Committees/Park Board-There was no meeting during this month because of Labor Day. Next meeting will be Oct. 7th.

Event Planning Committee/We discussed Wreath's Across America with Reba Smith present to help with this event. We are working toward this event and must register with the Gold Star Mothers. Will need to get the count of veterans at the cemetery. Next meeting Oct. 1st @ 6:00 PM.

We also so discussed the town picnic which will be held on Oct. 12th.

A motion to get two inflatables for this event at \$640.00 was made by K. Childers, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried.

History Committee/The committee met and cleaned and moved furniture to proper rooms for the Open House to be held on Oct. 12th. Next meeting Oct. 1st at 6:30 PM.

Health Committee/The town will have a Fall Clean Up on Oct. 18th & Oct. 19th. Brush, tree limbs, etc will be accepted. K. Childers will contact American Tree Expert to get a cost for this weekend. These dates were agreed upon by a motion by J. McLane, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried. Next meeting Sept. 30 @ 7:00.

Police Committee/Larry Wingo was present to report that he had a complaint about speeders on Rimrock Drive. He stated that they had patrolled this area and found the following:

Sept. 1st, no speeders while there. Second time 8:15 to 9:15, no speeders, 3rd time 4:45 to 6:45 no speeders and 1 warning wrote. 4th time 4:20 to 5:30 no speeders, 1 warning written. During the period of Oct. 17th, thru Oct. 31st 6,257 cars traveled there with the monitor set and only 3 people were over the speed limit.

Larry Wingo asked about the cost of accident reports and suggested that they be raised to \$20.00 per report. This was approved on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by J. Tolley & carried. Larry also reported that he had the new golf cart stickers for 19/20. Please be reminded that golf carts must be driven by a licensed driver. No underage drivers.

Filling Vacancies in Officers and Employees/ Mayor Clendenin reported that our utility clerk, Pam Black, which was hired on July 29th has decided to go back to school, and we have hired Michelle Flora which will start Monday.

Miscellaneous and Unfinished Business/

Council discussed the removal of trees from property on Hemlock Street. We have bids on the following: 3 tree limbs, 3 trees entirely, from App. Tree \$4,000, Jerry's Tree Service \$2,800 and Kevin stated that he would contact American Tree Expert for a quote. The property owner did cut down a tree on his property and let it fall into the park. This will need to be corrected by the owner of the tree. John Kosa was present to see about selling a strip of his property to his neighbor and needed to see what he needed to do. He presented a map detailing the property to the council. He has to fill out the county application and give to the town, to be put with the map, and the town will take care of. Once this has been done the council can vote on it at the next meeting.

Putnam County Special Olympics asked for Shelter #5 and the volleyball court for 9/22, fee waived, and was approved on a motion by J. Tolley, 2nd by K. Childers & carried.

Eleanor Explorers 4H club need Room C, fee waived for the 3rd quarter of 2019. One quarter was approved on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by T. Harmon & carried. They will need to ask for future quarters.

All business being complete at this time, the meeting adjourned at 8:35 PM.
