At 1:00pm the town council will host a special ribbon cutting ceremony for the new pavilion on the south lawn of the town hall.

The town hall and town museum will be open for tours, history discussions and pictures immediately following the ceremony until 3:00pm.

Starting at 4:00pm hotdogs, chips, drinks and desserts will be served at the Town Park in Shelter 5.

Also at 4:00pm, kids inflatables will be set up south of the tennis courts. The inflatable slide and bounce house will be open until 7:00pm.

Throughout the evening there will be live music at the gazebo, pumpkin painting, hayrides, roasting marshmallows, cornhole and other activities taking place throughout the park.

Town Elections

A public hearing has been scheduled to take place during the Thursday,
September 18th council meeting to discuss a potential change in how our town elections are administered.

Our town council, and anyone who may wish to participate, will discuss the pros and cons of having the Putnam County Clerks Office administer our elections.

Council will begin their regularly scheduled meeting at 7:30pm and this topic will discussed shortly after.

Please plan on arriving prior to 7:30pm to sign-in on the public hearing sign-up sheet. This meeting will be for information only and no voting will take place on this topic at that time.

Any permanent change on how the town's elections are administered can only happen through a town-wide vote. This will be the first conversation on how and if this question will appear on the ballot in June of 2020.

Fall 2019 Cleanup Event

The town will hold a Fall Cleanup Event that will take place Friday, October 18th and Saturday, October 19th.

Dumpsters will be placed in the pool parking lot and we are asking for residents to bring their items to that location. If any resident is unable to bring their items to this location, you may call the town hall to schedule a pickup at your residence.

Brush and other yard waste will be accepted.

Details of items accepted will be listed in the October newsletter and flyers will be posted at the town hall.

Putnam Co. Recreation Grant

Mayor Clendenin attended the Putnam **County Commission meeting on August** 22nd to present a grant proposal that was organized by the town's History Committee, Park Board and Town Council. The proposal requested for funding that will allow the town to replace the gazebo at the town park, add water and electric hook-ups at the new gazebo, to install stone veneer on the base and to create a handicap access ramp. The overall project includes replacing the broken sidewalks at the flower bed and a new concrete pad in front of the bleachers. However, the funding request was specific to the items to replace the gazebo.

During this meeting, the town was awarded \$23,482 through the Putnam County Commission Recreational Enhancement Fund Grant.

To secure this funding, all work must be completed by June 30, 2020. However, project walkthroughs have already been scheduled and we hope to break ground on this project very soon.
