2019 Decorating Contest

Judging will be completed by Friday, December 20th and winners will be notified in person or by phone prior to an announcement being placed at Town Hall and on the town's website.

All residents who are not elected officials or employed by the town are automatically entered. The contest is for exterior decorations only, including decorations in windows that are visible from the street. Judging will be done from the street outside the residence only. Judges will not enter property to view back or side yards.

Town Park Updates

The Town Park on Roosevelt Blvd. has experienced several changes in the last few months. Additional projects are either in progress or are projected to begin in the spring of 2020.

A small pathway and mulch has been added to the circular swing set area beside Shelter 5. This project is part of the Park Board's overall goal of creating a safe place where children of all abilities can play together.

Preliminary work has began on the two tennis courts to fill the cracks that have made the courts unplayable. Early next spring, both courts will be painted and new nets will be installed so they can be used again.

The leaning retaining wall at Shelter 1 has been torn down and new blocks have been installed. Roof repairs on this shelter and others are planned for the spring.

The construction of a new gazebo will be completed very soon. The original gazebo was beyond repair and a grant was received to fund the replacement.

The town's History Committee is currently working to create and install a plaque at the base of the new gazebo that will list the date and names of the individuals and groups who built the original gazebo in the mid 1970s.

Please take a few minutes to stop by the park to check these projects out.
