The 2020 Town of Eleanor elections will be held on Tuesday, June 9th at the Eleanor Town Hall's Homestead Room.

All elected positions serve two-year terms and will be on the ballot in June.

Those positions are: Mayor, Recorder and (5) Council Members.

Those interested in running for office will need to file for the office of their choice during the filing period.

Visit the Town Hall between Jan. 13th and Jan. 25th to file in person.

If filing by mail, your form must be postmarked by U.S. Postal Service no later than midnight on Jan. 27th.

The filing fee is \$5.00.

If you are not already registered to vote, you must be registered by May 19th to participate in this election.

You can register to vote in person at the Putnam County Clerk's office in Winfield.
