With council out of session, they agreed to have attorney Dee Price handle the letter to the business in question letting them know they may reopen as the original business on a motion by K. Childers, 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. McLane & carried.

Miscellaneous and Unfinished Business/

Talked with people doing filming in the park. Coordinate with Chief Wingo.
