If you have not responded to the census yet, you can do so online at:
www.my2020census.gov/login

This only takes 10 minutes to complete

Complete Step 1 or 2 after logging on to the site.

1. Enter your Census ID # that you received in the mail and then click Login.
2. If you did not receive anything in the mail, visit the webpage and then click on the blue text that says "If you do not have a Census ID, click here" and then follow the directions to obtain your ID so you can complete the questionnaire.

If you do not want to use a computer, you may call 1-844-330-2020 and access their phone system to complete the census questions.

Town of Eleanor—Park Information

**The parks will open certain areas on June 1st.
Information subject to change based on new information
and guidance provided by the State of West Virginia.**

General Information

- Follow social distancing guidelines and remain six feet apart.
- No more than 25 people are permitted in one general area at a time.
 - Avoid touching your face.
- Restrooms will ONLY be open on days a shelter is rented. These days will vary, so please be aware that restroom facilities may not be available during your visit unless you are a renter.

Playground Equipment

- A maximum of 25 people are permitted on the playground at one time.
- Please be courteous to others and limit your time on the playground when others are waiting.
- The playground is NOT being sanitized on a daily basis. Please bring your own hand sanitizer with you while on the playground. Utilize the hand sanitizer before and after using each piece of equipment.

Basketball Courts & Tennis Courts

- All basketball courts will remain closed until further notice.
- Tennis courts will be open once painting and repairs have been completed. Gameplay must be limited to two individuals only with no other spectators inside the fenced area.

Grass Fields

- No other contact sports are permitted, such as soccer, football, etc.

Picnic Shelters

- All shelter rules are not optional and must be adhered to for continued operation.
- Shelters are available for rent beginning June 1st by calling 304-586-2319.
- It is the responsibility of the renter to guarantee no more than 25 people will be at the shelter at any time. This is the maximum permitted at this time.
 - Renters are required to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- The shelter and restrooms will be cleaned prior to each rental.

Baseball Fields

- Youth softball and baseball is scheduled to begin on June 8th.
- Final guidance by the state has not been received, information will be released as soon as the town has them.
 - Fields are closed until June 8th.

Disc Golf / Hiking / Biking Trails / Archery Range

- All of these areas are open but the general social distancing and individual group numbers must be followed.

Town Activity and First Responder Reports

From the of Police Chief Larry Wingo

As we switch gears from spring to the summer season, I would like to remind everyone of a few things. First, with the warmer weather, more people are venturing out. Please be mindful of the speed limits; 20 miles per hour in town, 25 miles per hour on Eleanor Circle and 45 miles per hour on Route 62. Bike riders please follow the flow of traffic and ride with the flow of traffic.

It is safer for everyone.

Something else that has been brought to our attention is golf carts, side by sides, 4-wheelers and dirt bikes. If you have a golf cart, or side by side and want to ride them in town, the following must happen. You must apply for a permit and registration sticker. These are available through the Town Hall. Golf carts and side by sides must have the registration sticker affixed to the vehicle. You must provide insurance and you have to have a valid driver's license. If you wish to ride the vehicle at night, you must have lights to the front and rear. You may not exceed the maximum passengers as per the manufactures limits.

NO ONE without a valid driver's license may operate a golf cart or side by side in town. Side by sides may only be ridden on town streets. You may cross a Rt 62 at a 90 degree angle.

Golf carts can be ridden on town streets and sidewalks, but all golf carts MUST yield to pedestrians and be the ones who pull off the sidewalk to allow walkers, bikers and joggers pass by.

Dirt bikes and 4-wheelers are not allowed on any streets, town, county owned properties or where it is posted "private property" or "no trespassing".

If someone is found to be riding on the aforementioned areas, they may be subjected to a fine and having the vehicle towed.

With your help in these matters, we will be able to continue to allow the side by sides and golf carts in our town. We appreciate your cooperation and enjoy the month of June

Free Dumpster Weekend

The cleanup event has been rescheduled to take place on Friday, June 26th and Saturday, June 27th.

Between 9am and 6pm on each day, residents may bring (or have picked up) one truck load of items. For those dropping their items off, please drive to the Eleanor Pool parking lot during the time frame listed. Your MUST have a copy of your sewer bill or proof of physical address when you arrive. Volunteers will be on hand to help you unload. If you wish to have items picked up at your home, please call the Town Hall to schedule a day. To make it easier on the volunteers, please have your items out by the curb. Any small or loose items must be in a bag or container.

The town will receive or pick up tree and brush clippings, furniture, appliances, and up to 10 tires per household.

Items not accepted are trees and branches greater than 18", piles of dirt, radioactive or asbestos materials, batteries, paint (unless it is dried up in the can), any volatile, corrosive, flammable, explosive, biomedical, infectious, bio-hazardous or regulated medical waste or toxic substance. If you have an item you are unsure about, call the town hall and ask.

Reminder: This is for town residents only and you may have items picked up or dropped off one time on each day.

Yard Sales

Permits for yard sales will be available beginning on June 1st. Permits at \$1.00 Yard sales must be limited to one family at each site and good social distancing must be followed at all times.

At this point the Fall Town-Wide Yard Sale has not been canceled and may take place on Thursday, October 1st and ending on Saturday, October 3rd. Please keep in mind that this event is subject to change due to potential new guidelines issued by the State at that time.

Community Shout Outs

COVID guidelines prevented the yearly ceremony from happening, but a group of individuals worked to plant American flags by the headstones of our Veterans and to place and light the luminaries throughout the cemetery.
