Standing Committees/

Resolution for the grant was read and allowed for mayor's signature on a motion by K. Childers, 2nd by J. McLane & carried.

Sewer/Storm Water meeting report/Extension in North Woods, 1100 feet, three property owners is being complete at \$15,000.
