Standing Committees/ Police Committee

This contract would be for five years. The extra car could be fixed up by the PCTC for this officer. Everything would be paid for by the Board.

The person vandalizing the park was caught and he and his mother cleaned up the mess he had caused. The corona virus cleaning by the National Guard is free. After Homestead room is cleaned up we may do this.

The needed camera's in the park that are needed can be discussed with Ron Arthur, Chief of Police at Winfield.

Grant Discussion with Laura Cox. She passed copies of the grant that was submitted. They will be meeting here in Eleanor on Oct. 13th, 14th, and 15th.

Council agreed to have Trick or Treat Oct. 31st, from 6:00 to 8:00 as set by the county using the CDC guidelines. If you do not want to participate, leave lights off.

The CARES Act grant has been submitted up through August.

Council decided since the last town wide clean up was just the last weekend of June, we would not have another in October.

Rooms still cannot be rented at this time.

Miscellaneous and Unfinished Business/The town will make an effort to remove plants/grass etc from around fire hydrants so that they can be spotted easily.
