The grant submitted to the county on time for \$9200 for sidewalk in park. We were awarded \$9,000 In the springtime we will pour walks. Fairground got \$30,000 for new lights & poles plus they have \$18,000 left from security that was not used.

We have asked Rich Pullins to attend the Park Board meeting in January to discuss cleaning up after Jeep Fest.
